100% LIGHTFAST

Lightfastness refers to the chemical stability of a pigment under long exposure to light. Derwent Lightfast pencils have been formulated to be 100% lightfast, meaning the core is resistant to colour change. This ensures artwork will not fade for up to 100 years under museum conditions.

Tested in both Florida and Arizona, under the harshest conditions, pigments are certified for lightfast quality using indoor accelerated weather machines and out in the baking Arizonian sunlight.

All colours comply with internationally recognised lightfast testing standard ASTM D6901 as well as Blue Wool Scale ISO 105.

ASTM D6901: A scale of LFI-V with values LFI and LFII resisting fading for up to 100 years

Blue Wool Scale ISO 105: A scale of 1-8 with values of 6-8 resisting fading for up to 100 years.


TEXTUR
