### CREAMY, OPAQUE LAYDOWN

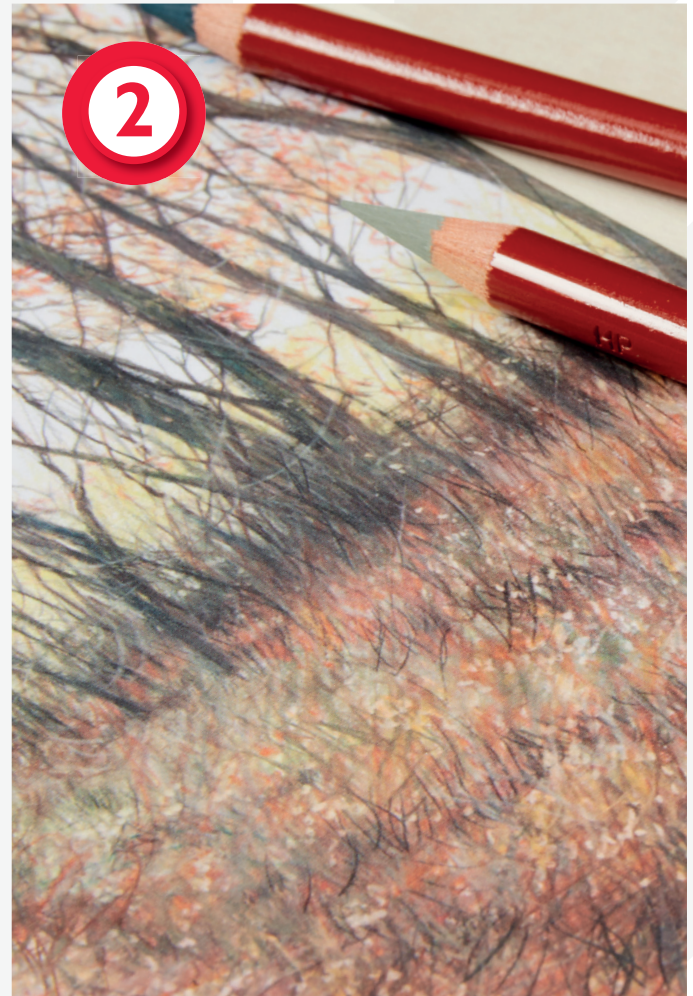
The texture of the Derwent Drawing range is similar to Derwent Lightfast, and they are also 100% resistant to colour change for up to 100 years. However, Derwent Drawing Pencils have a wax-based, rather than oil-based, core.

Colours will blend and mix together with ease on the page. They also have a very pigmented, opaque laydown, meaning application on mid-tone and dark papers will work very well.

“This range of pencils is unique - they have qualities not found in other colour pencils. I love the strong pigmentation giving great covering power, but at the same time allowing many layers to show through. I have adapted my technique to get the best out of these pencils, and to fully exploit their superb qualities. I like using them with Derwent Graphic to create bold landscapes. I find them very robust in use, allowing me to make expressive marks and gestures.”
