

Derwent Tinted Charcoal offers the dramatic beauty of charcoal with a gentle hint of colour. Professional quality, this range offers an array of muted shades, ideal for adding colour details and accents to charcoal drawings.

The addition of colour pigments to both Tinted Charcoal Pencils and Tinted Charcoal Paint does not detract from the distinctive element of charcoal "blackness" in the Derwent Tinted Charcoal collection.





MATTE, TEXTURED FINISH

There are not many comparable ranges to Derwent Tinted Charcoal on the market, as others behave more like pastel media; with the proportion of charcoal material, versus colour pigment, relatively low.

The key difference between the two media types is that tinted charcoal is transparent while pastels are opaque. Charcoal has a delicate layer, pastel is dense in its colour application.

Tinted Charcoal Paint dries with a contemporary matte textured finish, unlike Graphitint Paint (graphite and colour combined), which dries with a silvery sheen. Tinted Charcoal Paint can also be easily lifted with an eraser once dry.
