TEXTURE OF WILLOW CHARCOAL

There are not many comparable ranges to Derwent Tinted Charcoal on the market, as others behave more like pastel media; with the proportion of charcoal material, versus colour pigment, relatively low.

The key difference between the two media types is that tinted charcoal is transparent while pastels are opaque. Charcoal has a delicate layer, pastel is dense in its colour application.
